1. Back ground:

Community Empowerment and Rehabilitation Initiative for Development (CERID) is a non – for-profit local organization found in Koboko district legally registered in 2017 with the Uganda National NGO Bureau Reg No. 12951. As a local initiative CERID was formed to focus on the most vulnerable groups in the society especially the Women and Youth. CERID is a community centered organization that is committed to working with disadvantaged communities to pursue her goal and objective of transforming rural-urban communities in areas of Community Health; Livelihoods; Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH); and Environment.

2. About GBV Programme:

CERID is implementing a one (1) year project entitled “Integrate GBV prevention and assistance to urban refugees and host community in Koboko Municipality Koboko District” funded by PEPFAR Uganda Community Grant to Combat HIV/AIDS - US Embassy Kampala

The trainer is expected to conduct training on local molding of Fuel Efficient Stoves (FES) for 15 GBV survivor for three (3) days in Koboko Municipality.

- Develop a simple training Manual and activity based facilitator's guide on local molding of Fuel Efficient Stoves (FES).
- Conduct training of 15 GBV survivors for three (3) days on local molding of Fuel Efficient Stoves (FES).
- Any other duty as assigned by CERID regarding the assignment.

6. Expected output:

- Final methodology and training guide / manual.
- Action plan developed
- Training conducted
- Report written in time

7. Reporting.

The trainer will work under the overall guidance of the CERID Executive Director and GBV project Officer. CERID will provide any other necessary support that will facilitate the training and the trainer will present the final reports to CERID.

8. Trainer Skills and Experience Required

- At least 1 years of practical experience in local molding of stoves using local materials
- 1 year of experience in related training interventions or relevant field particularly in GBV / AIDS.
- Adequate facilitation and training skills
- Strong documentation and presentation skills
